

TAP Camp FAQ's

1. What are the dates?
 - June 18th - August 10th (8 weeks)
 - You can register for 1 week or for all 8 weeks
2. What are the times?
 - 9am-3pm for camp
 - There will no longer be half-day camp provided
 - 7am-9am for before care
 - 3pm-5pm for after care
3. What is the cost?
 - \$450 per week for camp
 - \$10 per hour for before and after care
 - Funding sources can be found at <http://www.ddamaryland.org/liss.htm>
 - Camp is covered for all Medicaid Waiver students under Therapeutic Integration Services
4. When does registration begin?
 - Monday March 5th at 9am
 - Please register via email to theautismproject@cs.com for your preferred week
 - Registration will be on a first come first serve basis
 - Registration is final after June 1st and any cancellations after that will be charged a \$25 fee
 - Placement for those campers entering into the 6th grade will be based on staffs discretion for the middle school/high school camp versus the elementary school camp
5. Will there be a waitlist?
 - Once max registration has been met there will be a waitlist taken for each week
 - Waitlist registrants will ideally be notified a week in advance but please keep in mind that last minute notifications are possible
6. What will a typical day at camp consist of?
 - The Elementary and Middle/High School Camps will be different with their day to day activities
 - All campers will be swimming weekly
 - Elementary School Campers will swim every Tuesday and Thursday
 - Middle/High School Campers will swim every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday
 - All campers will be going on community outings weekly
 - Elementary Campers will go every Wednesday
 - Middle/High Campers will go to Yoga every Tuesday and various outings every Thursday
 - All campers will participate in a variety of activities; including: art and crafts, fitness and physical play, board games, outdoor sports and games and much more.
7. What will the staff to child ratio be for camp?
 - The ratio will vary depending on those registered but will always be at least 1:3 for the Elementary and 1:5 for the Middle/High School
8. What if your child takes medicine during camp hours?
 - The medication can be distributed daily and a weekly amount can be stored at TAP
 - A completed medication form is required for distribution
